**RE: Workplace Mandates**

Dear Kaiser Member:

This pandemic has wrecked havoc upon our communities, our workplaces and our families. Yet, through all of this, your labor has ensured that medical attention will be directed to all those who need it. Thank you.

UFCW Local 770 is proud of our role in helping front-line essential workers, such as yourself, not only get priority access to COVID-19 vaccines, but also providing them: our sponsored vaccination clinics have distributed more than 20,000 shots to date.

As much as we encourage everyone eligible to protect themselves, their families, and their co-workers by getting these safe and effective vaccines, we remain committed to protecting worker contractual rights regarding workplace mandates.

That is why we are insisting on meet and confer requirements for ALL workplace mandates. We are demanding that Kaiser adhere to our contract before any workplace mandates are implemented. This is an issue that is previously agreed upon and is a common-sense step before implementing workplace mandates. We will be meeting with the Company shortly, and will keep you all updated on the progress of our bargaining there.

In the meantime, we encourage ALL our eligible members to protect themselves, their families, and their co-workers by getting vaccinated, wearing masks, and following hygiene protocols like frequently washing hands.
